Governor Schwarzenegger Issues Statement on Death of Covina Police Department Sergeant Scott Hanson

Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger today released the following statement regarding the death of Covina Police Department Sergeant Scott Hanson of Covina: "Along with the great privilege of serving in law enforcement comes the great risk of injury and death. Sergeant Hanson faithfully fulfilled his duties on behalf of his fellow Californians and we will remain forever grateful for his service. Maria and I join all Californians in sending our deepest condolences to Scott's family, friends and fellow peace officers. His brave legacy will continue on in our hearts." Hanson, 45, died July 3 as a result of head injuries sustained from an on-duty traffic collision on August 14, 2003. Sergeant Hanson is survived by his wife Allison, daughter, Sarah and son, Andrew. He was a 22-year veteran of the Covina Police Department. In honor of Sergeant Hanson, Capitol flags will be flown at half-staff.
