Governor Schwarzenegger Issues Statement on Death of California Highway Patrol Officer Brent Clearman

Governor Schwarzenegger today released the following statement regarding the death of Officer Brent William Clearman of Concord: "Californians owe a debt of gratitude to the brave men and women who put themselves in constant danger to keep us safe. Officer Clearman exemplified that commitment and courageously made the ultimate sacrifice. Our hearts go out to his friends and family during this difficult time." Clearman, 33, died August 6 as a result of injuries sustained when a vehicle struck him while he was investigating a traffic collision on the northbound I-880 in Oakland. He is survived by wife, Cathy Jo. Officer Clearman has been with the California Highway Patrol for nearly two years. In honor of Officer Clearman, Capitol flags will be flown at half-staff.
